A crown (or cap) is used to bolster and protect the tooth's structure that cannot be renewed with fillings or other kinds of oral health restorations. A cap is a cover that overlays the whole tooth's surface to restore it to its initial dimensions and shape.

There are several distinctive variations of tooth crowns on the marketplace with porcelain tooth-coloured crowns being the most popular due to their resemblance to natural teeth. They are very durable and can endure for many years, but like many tooth restorations, they may ultimately need to be replaced. Ceramic crowns are fabricated at a dental laboratory to match the size, form, and colour of your teeth presenting you a beautiful and long-term organic smile.

Crowns are most frequently employed as an answer to fractured or broken teeth, an aesthetic enhancement, to envelop an endodontic therapy, to wrap a fractured filling, or to replace large fillings.
