The drill free method is recent to dentistry and allows the oral health care professional to complete painfree therapies for the most hesitant of patients. Drill free has all the benefits that are currently being offered by the standard dental drill in a novel revolutionary method known as air abrasion.

Performing duties like removing pockets or removing decay from teeth may be accomplished by air abrasion in a far milder approach than with a dental drill. This technique makes use of very tiny abrasive particles being thrust by powerful streams of air to help eliminate dental caries from teeth while stopping the caries from spreading any further.

After any decay has been removed and the tooth has been properly prepared, your oral health care provider might fill the affected site with a dental filling. Dentists might put on a sealant, or employ a ceramic or composite resin tooth coloured filling on the face of the tooth.
